## Remote Learning

### What you need to know

*School starts August 17, 2020 in person unless the Governor orders no in-person schooling again. SUSD will conduct Remote Learning in place of in-person school, bringing back students, safely, as the Department of Education allows us to so. Safety measures will be put into places via the CDC.*

Devices Being Used by Students	K-8 – Apple IPADs 9-12 – Dell Laptops
Remote Learning	SUSD will be using a remote learning model to educate students for the most part. Students' day will be similar to regular in-person school, but they will not physically be in the building.
Online Classes SchoolsPLP	Many students will still have some online classes, especially in grade 7-12. Classes like Spanish, Coding, or Credit Recovery. There will be a certified teacher monitoring them, but all the content and teaching will be through Schools PLP.
Learning Management System (LMS) Schools PLP	This platform is used to house instructional material including, but not limited to student work, assignments from teachers, assessments, written class discussions, videos, etc. Teachers will be adding their own material to this site and each have their own classes on it for students to access.
Platform for Classes-Microsoft Teams Part of Microsoft Office Suite	Students will have a class schedule & will be expected to join a Team Meeting for each class they have throughout the day. This is where students will be taught for remote learning. They will get to see and interact with their teacher and classmates daily while we have to do remote learning due to Covid-19. This will be the primary communication avenue for Teachers with Students for due dates, announcements, etc. If they are late to the class, they are marked tardy. If they do not show up for the class, they will be marked absent.
